Rigid Tine Chisel Plough

An economically priced robust machine designed for hard work.

- Used in a similar fashion to the stump jump chisel plough, however, as it is rigid there is no "give" in its action. Clamp bolts will shear under load. Designed for clean country and is ideal in lighter sandy soils where penetration and draft are not a problem.
- Heavy duty 100 x 100 x 6mm frame.
- Tine are made from silicone chrome spring steel with 300mm spacing.
- Available in 5, 7, 9 and 11 tine models with optional wheelkits.



Coil Tine Chisel Plough

Heavy Duty primary and secondary cultivator—ideal where deep penetration is required without bringing subsoil to the surface



- Commonly used in market garden operations to penetrate beneath the normal level of cultivation.
 The coil allows the tine to move, assisting penetration and reducing horsepower requirement.
- 30mm square high resistance hardened double coil tines do not disturb the surface as much as wider chisel plough tines. This is useful in such operations as pasture renovation and plough or rotary hoe pan breaking. The finer tine is also good for secondary cultivation where a heavy machine is needed for heavier soils.
